



DAY 1: ARRIVAL AT YANGON

Upon arrival at airport at about 13.45 hrs, after luggage collection, you will be welcome by local tour guide. Then transfer to your hotel for check-in.

Yangon (formerly Rangoon) is the largest city in Myanmar (formerly Burma). A mix of colonial architecture, modern high-rises and gilded Buddhist pagodas define its skyline. Its famed Shwedagon Paya, a huge, shimmering pagoda complex, draws thousands of pilgrims annually. The city's other notable religious sites include the Botataung and Sule pagodas, both housing Buddhist relics.

DAY 2: HALF DAY YANGON CITY TOUR

Join Expeditions Myanmar on a Half day tour to experience the highlights of YANGON, Myanmar's largest city.

Following pick up, the day starts with a visit to the magnificent reclining Buddha at CHAUK THAT GYI PAGODA and visit to BOGYOKE / SCOTTS MARKET allows you to experience a colorful maze made up of hundreds of gemstone, handicraft, art, clothes, and food sellers.

The day ends at the spectacular golden monument that is SWEDAGON PAGODA, the spiritual heart of all Myanmar and an iconic symbol of a country that is not to be missed.

DAY 3: DEPARTURE YANGON ARRIVAL PHNOM PENH

After enjoying breakfast, check-out of your hotel and proceed to the airport to board flight for Phnom Penh which retains its traditional Khmer and colonial styles with French villas and large tree-line sidewalk. Upon arrival, picked up by our local tour guide and transfer to check in hotel. At leisure for the rest of the day. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 04: PHNOM PENH CITY TOUR

Have breakfast at hotel. This morning, we will visit the impressive colorful Khmer-style Royal Palace complex built in 1866 by the Predecessors of King Norodom. Nearby is Silver pagoda (the emerald Buddha temple), which contains plenty of Buddha Statues decorated and made by gold, diamond, gemstone and silver. We will stop at Independence monument and explore the National museum, a beautiful Khmer architecture building which contains more than 5000 art antiques made by bronze, wood, gold, silver, copper, sandstone and others. We pass through the river-front park where 4 rivers met at a junction include mystical Mekong. Walk up to sacred hill Phnom Daun Penh – also the name of a pagoda and name of the capital nowadays. This afternoon, we visit Tuol Sleng prison, now called Genocide Museum, the most secret part of the Khmer Rouge regime. It's also called S-21 (abbreviated for Security Office 21), a Khmer Rouge's premier security camp, specifically designed for the interrogation and extermination of anti-Angkor elements. Leave the relics of the bad history of Cambodia, we go shopping around Russian market; enjoy the bustling daily activities of the locals. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 05: DEPARTURE PHNOM PENH -- ARRIVAL HO CHI MINH

After breakfast catch flight for Ho Chi Minh.

Welcome to Ho Chi Minh – the most hectic and business city of Vietnam. Upon arrival at airport, welcomed by the local tour guide and transfer to the city center to check in hotel. Afternoon, we start the city tour at the Reunification Palace, the witness of the fierce Vietnam War ended in 1975. The grand building today is a Museum and Hall of official receptions. Nearby the Palace is the colonial-styled Central Post Office, one of the city's major landmarks. Have a walking tour on Nguyen Hue street to take the photos of the Opera House (outside) and the Ho Chi Minh Committee (outside). From here, walk to Ben Thanh Market one of the most typical symbol of Ho Chi Minh to experience the daily life of the locals and do shopping the hand-made goods there. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

DAY 06: HO CHI MINH – SIC TOUR TO MEKONG DELTA – HO CHI MINH

Have breakfast at hotel. Picked up at hotel and join SIC tour to My Tho, the homeland of coconut and family factories with local products like coconut candy, rice paper,... Upon arrival, embark on the boat cruising on the mighty Mekong River viewing the life to the local people live along the banks. We stop at one of 4 islands in the area for sightseeing. Enjoy the fresh tropical fruits served in the heart of the garden accompanied by traditional southern Vietnamese folk music at the plantation. After that you will embark on the small boats rowed by the local people thru the small canals with water coconut tree to visit the local factories. There you will taste the honey tea and see the local people produce the coconut candy milk and of course you also can try it or stroll in the garden where the locals feed honeybee. After that enjoy the horse-cart trip through the tranquil road of the village. We continue getting on the big boat to visit the vast area. Enjoy your light lunch at a local restaurant nearby Mekong River with the Elephant Ear fish. Afternoon, drive to visit Vinh Trang pagoda, a famous pagoda in the area that its architecture is a mix of Chinese, Cambodian, and French culture. Drop off at your hotel and overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

DAY 07: HO CHI MINH – SIC TOUR TO CU CHI TUNNELS – AFTERNOON FLIGHT TO MANILA

Have breakfast and check out hotel. Morning, join SIC tour to visit Cu Chi Tunnels, one of the few remaining monuments to the Vietnam War. Beneath the ground lie 200 km of tunnels, dug by hand and inhabited by the forces of the Vietnamese guerillas during the conflict. At its peak, prior to the Tet Offensive in 1968, the tunnel complex was base to almost 10,000 troops. To this day, it remains one of the most impressive examples of how fierce the war used to be. You even can try to crawl some dozens of m on the tunnel underground to have the real experience. This afternoon, we transfer to the airport for flight to Manila. Upon arrival, picked up by our local tour guide and transfer to check in hotel. At leisure for the rest of the day. Overnight in Manila.

DAY 8: MANILA SIGHTSEEING

After Breakfast at the Hotel start Manila City Tour *Visit Rizal Park, also known as Luneta Park or simply Luneta, is a historical urban park in the Philippines, it has gardens, historical markers, plazas, a grand stadium, an observatory, an open-air concert hall, an artists' sanctuary, a light-and-sound theatre, restaurants, food kiosks and playgrounds, and dozens of fountains. *Explore Intramuros, also known as "The Walled City," pertained to be the oldest district in Manila. This is what remains of the fortified city, which was the seat of power during Spanish Colonial times (1521-1898). *Admire the beauty and history of Fort Santiago that features a museum and public park was built as a stone fortress at the turn of the 17th century and marked the beginning of the walled city's riverside barricades. *See San Agustin Church, considered as one of the oldest stone churches in the country, having survived 2 fires and 7 earthquakes. Indian Lunch, then, the tour continues to: *Stroll Ayala Centre Shops it brings various lifestyle brands, boutiques, dining spots, and hangouts to the city. Those residing along the busy arteries of Makati have access to shopping malls, arcades, and cinemas without taking an hour-long drive. *Drive thru Bay Yacht Club, PICC and World Trade Center, and SM Mall of Asia Back to Hotel
